
Delaware River Gap National Recreation Area

Stillwater Township, New Jersey

The town of Stillwater was settled by Palatine German in the early eighteenth century. They entered though Philadelphia and settled along the Paulinskill River in north western New Jersey. These early settlers were essentially German, among them were Johann Georg Windemuth and his father-in-law Johann Peter Bernhardt and over many years they help grow their settlement. They help establish a church which was shared by the Lutheran and German Reformed (Calvinist) congregations. Today many stone homes remain including the Johann Georg Windemuth and his son Peter, both are located next to the Stillwater Cemetery.

The cemetery has been a burial ground for the past 260 years with our may of our ancestors buried there. The first church building were built with logs, between 1745 to 1750, and the second building from fieldstone. Around 1847 a new church building was constructed a short distance from the cemetery.

The Historical Society of Township Museum is located in a 1842 year old school building. The school was known as the Academy and operated from 1842 to 1909. The Museum has a schoolmaster's desk from the 1800's and upstairs there is a cannonball from the Wintermute Foundry which was located on Fairview Lake Road.

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
Fort Wintermute (Wintemoot) Wilkes-Barre:

A stockade house built by our ancestors, who sided with the British as the American forces attack the Wyoming Valley in July 1778 and as a result the stockade was burned.


